Sub: Conducting of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination for promotion from Postman/Mail Guard/Despatch Rider and MTS cadre to the cadre of Postal Assistants / Sorting Assistants, for the vacancy 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018 (from 01-04-2018 to 31-12-2018).

In continuation of this office notification dated 23-10-2018 and in compliance with the interim orders of Hon'ble CAT, Bengaluru orders dated 04-12-2018 in OA No. 1791/2018 and 1792/2018 (copy enclosed), it is directed by the Competent Authority to conduct Limited Departmental Competitive Examination for promotion of Lower Grade Officials to the cadre of Postal Assistant / Sorting Assistants for the vacancy year 2018 (01-04-2018 to 31-12-2018) along with vacancies of 2016-17 and 2017-18. **The examination will be held on Sunday, the 09-12-2018.**

2. **Vacancy for the year 2018 (01-04-2018 to 31-12-2018) will be arrived later subject to cadre restructuring exercise.**

3. **Eligibility Conditions:-**

4. **Examination Centre:** The examination will be conducted at three centres in the Circle i.e Bengaluru , Hassan and Dharwad. The candidates have option to appear from the above centres only. However, the candidates working on deputation to APS will take the Examination from the nearest Civil Centre of their circle.

5. **All the candidates who submit applications for the vacancy year 2018 may be allowed provisionally subject to verification of eligibility conditions as per the recruitment rules and instructions issued from time to time. In addition to this the procedure as laid down by the Hon'ble CAT, Bengaluru Bench in interim order in OA No. 1791/2018 and 1792/2018 dated 04-12-2018 (copy enclosed) may also be followed.**

a) **Anybody who comes in may be allowed to write the examination regardless of their eligibility or not at the time which will be determined at a later stage.**

b) **All these people can write the examination and then later on can join as parties. If it is later found that they have wrongly written the examination without any basis entitling them to appear in this exam, we will impose a cost on them. On this understanding only they will be allowed to write the examination.**

iv) All the results will be kept in a sealed cover .

6. MS-Excel sheet format of those candidates who are permitted provisionally based on this notification in Annexure-III may be sent by E-Mail/phone on **07-12-2018 at 17 hours.**


7. All the applicants appearing for the vacancy year 2018 should have completed three/five years as the case may be as on 01-04-2018.

8. **The scrutiny of the provisionally permitted candidates for vacancy year 2018 will be done by the concerned Divisional/Regional office later on except the service condition.**

9. All other terms and conditions mentioned in notification dated 23-10-2018 shall remain same.





		<p>Sl. No.22&23 KBS(MJ)/DS(MA) 04.12.2018</p> <p>We heard the matter relating to whether or not the applicant should write the examination right now. We feel that if at all we have to err, it is better to err on the side of the angel. Right now it is the applicant because as per the guidelines issued by DG, all other circles have adopted 31.12.2018 as the crucial date whereas in Karnataka it is 31.03.2018. We need to examine the rightness or wrongness of this but till then if the applicant is not allowed the chance to write the examination he will lose a valuable right which we cannot recoup at a later stage. Therefore there will be an interim order to the respondents to allow the applicant to write the examination. At this point of time a crucial point is raised by Shri Vishnu Bhat, learned counsel for the respondents, that there may be others equivalent to the situation of the applicant who may not have come to the Court but who are eligible to write this examination along with the applicant had it been notified as 31.12.2018 in accordance with the DG's guidelines instead of 31.03.2018. Even if others also apply for this, they may be allowed to write the examination and their results also be</p>



In any case, if others also write the examination and their results kept in a sealed cover, no harm will be done. Therefore we will await the reply. Four more weeks granted to file a composite reply encompassing these reasons also. 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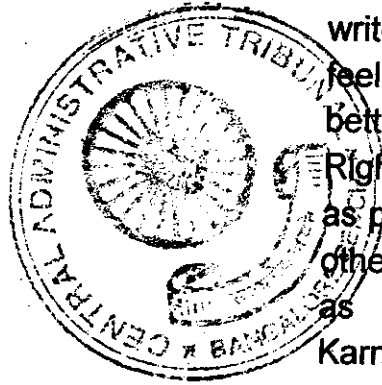
